In order to provide the best possible experience for everyone, there are certain rules and policies that have been established for the health and safety of all involved.

1. For consideration in the camp, **child must be available to attend ALL SCHEDULED DAYS**. Exceptions for illness and injury are allowed.
2. The child agrees to abide by the rules and regulations set by the Career Camp for the health, safety and welfare of all children.
3. Children are not allowed to smoke, chew tobacco, and possess any smoking materials, alcohol, or illegal drugs. Vending machines are off limits for purchases.
4. Personal Electronics (iPod, Mp3 player, cell phones, iPod shuffle, Game Boy, tablets) use **is NOT** permitted during the camp. Devices will be confiscated and returned at the end of camp.
5. All medication/prescribed drugs must be kept under the control of the Director.
6. Children are not to possess or use firecrackers or explosives. Children may not possess weapons of any kind.
7. Willful destruction to property will be the financial responsibility of the child's parent.
8. Children may not leave the property or established boundaries without Career Camp staff permission.
9. Continued inappropriate behavior, including: not following directions, teasing, sexual harassment and/or intimidation, threatening other children or staff members, and improper behavior in transportation vehicles, may result in **IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL FROM THE CAMP**. In the event this occurs, it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to pick up or arrange for transportation of the child to their home.

We reserve the right and **WILL** send **ANYONE** home (at parent's expense and liability) that violates these rules. The program director reserves the right to determine what constitutes a violation of these rules and will enforce them as necessary.
